> I have a user (X) who needs to send email from 2 different addresses. I've
> created an AD account for the second address(Y) and given user X 'Send As'
> privilege in the Security tab of the properties for Y.
>
> This generates an NDR (You do not have permission to send to this
> recipient)
> when X sends a mail with Y in the From field in Outlook. I've also tried
> adding 'Full mailbox rights' for X in Y's account but still get the NDRs.
>
> The relay restrictions allow only our internal network or authenticated
> users to relay.
>
