OMA should be enabled by default - if not, check the settings for mobile access. hit <http://server/OMA> to check it out. If the PDA is a Treo by chance, skip the normal mail and use VersaMail - it has it's problems but it integrates nicely with exchange, and recent Treo's have it included "free". I say free because as much as the treo's cost, you may have inadvertently signed away your firstborn.
