>We have SB server 2003 running exchange. We have 7 people in office A and 3  
>in office B. The server is in office A. Our offices are not linked  
>directly, yet. All of our email end in @email.com. Our email is hosted by  
>our webguy in POP3 and exchange downloads in office A and just Outlook  
>downloads in office B. When we want to send email to Office B from Office A  
>it will not send because the server see a email that ends with @email.com so  
>it thinks it is staying in the office and will not send it out to the  
>internet. The workaround is in Outlook we have created a POP3 for outgoing  
>email. So when office A sends to office B we must specify to use the POP3  
>account and not exchange. It is becoming more and more of a hassle and we  
>would like exchange to shoot the email to the internet so office B can  
>download. How do we go about this.
