DGs are not security principals, so these cannot appear in ACLs (i.e. cannot be assigned permissions on any resource).

Create a Security Group and assign it Send As permissions to the mailbox/user (by going to user's account properties in ADUC | Security | add group | check "Allow" next to "Send As"). Make users who need permission on the mailbox members of that group. (If currently logged on, they will need to log-off and log-on again.... before they can access).
