>> it across all PCs to make sure they don't logon to a teacher's machine
>> for example. I'd suggest you experiment but prohibiting interactive logon
>> should take care of the biggest part of your problem. You cam also
>> configure each account so that access is restricted to only OWA even if
>> they do manage to get logged onto a machine.
