I got activesync working by giving up on trying to figure out what permissions changes to make in IIS and just running the internet connection wizard in the SBS server management page and checking to allow mobile access (I forget the exact phrasing, but you'll see it if you go through the wizard). All other setting will remain the same as long as you don't change them so you don't have to worry about breaking anything. I haven't gone back through yet to try to figure out what exactly it changed, but my mobile clients all got access after I ran the wizard when they previously had access denied errors.
