We have recently migrated to Exchange 2003 and are dealing with the "we used to be able to do this on <insert name of any mail server here>..." gripes.

One of the things that certain high-end users are complaining about is the fact that they are no longer able to access their multiple mailboxes using a Treo device. Previously, they would just create a bunch of POP or IMAP connections to the Sendmail server and access all their mailboxes, but we have not enabled POP or IMAP to the Internet for security reasons (although users can use IMAP after making a VPN connection).

Anyway, is there any way that users can, without a lot of effort, connect to 2 or 3 mailboxes using their Treo's? We have users set up with ActiveSync, but that only gets you one mailbox. We are willing to investigate add-on solutions if necessary. The idea of using OWA from their Treo's was shot down quickly.
