I work for a school and very few people receive email from other countries yet the email headers of 99% of the spam that is getting through our filtering software is from foreign IP addresses (china, korea, spain, etc.). We use GFI mail essentials but it has not been as effective as we'd like. I want to blacklist foreign smtp servers but still be able to whitelist certain senders based on their email address. GFI does not allow this and exchange's virtual smtp server can block ip addresses but it won't allow for exceptions based on sender email address. For example, block all IP addresses from Korea unless the sender is jsmith@xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx Any ideas?
