Yes, that server will probably require AUTH.
But your mail server should not be sending to that server.

If you go to dsnstuff.com and do a DNS lookup for yahoo.com of the type MX (for Mail eXchange) then you will get a list of the servers that accept mail for the yahoo.com domain.....

Try telnetting into one of those and sending to your yahoo address from an external address.
