When a user opens the global address book in Outlook, they can modify group membership. How do I restrict them from being able to modify these groups?

What minimum permissions do they need to be just able to read the members of those groups?

Authenticated Users and Everyone only have: Read; Execute; read Permissions; List Contents; Read Properties; and List Object.

These were all setup by default, in other word, they came with the creation of the group
