Thanks for your reply Susan,
With your help here's what I found that looks like it will work. Does this look right to you?

Create a new "Recipient Policy" and select "Mailbox Manager Settings", Name it and set the filter to include "Users with Exchange Mailbox" then go to the "Mailbox Manager Settings (Policy)" tab and configure what exactly I want this to run on, Inbox, Sent Items, Deleted Items, etc. Set the age per item and remove the size and set the option to "Delete Immediately". Apply the policy.
