I had an Exchange 2003 behind a firewall (not ISA). All was OK.

I added an Ex2007 (which will take over once I move everything to it and decommission). All roles on one box. I changed the firewall to point port 80 and 443 to the new server.

I just tried it again to check for other error messages and it works now! I didn't change anything. If it happens again, I'll collect the error.
