From my understanding, sending from gmail sometimes results in blank emails? Have you tried comparing the headers to see if they are the same from a gmail message with a subject vs a blank subject? Headers may also show some spam confidence markers or other info that may be useful. Also have you checked your symantec logs or try bypassing gmails servers?
