Followed steps to remove OWA virtual directories on IIS, then recreated. Then, to be safe, I touched base with Net Sol and renewed the cert with a new key...as I'd only renewed last week and everything with the cert request was in order, they turned the new renew request around in 45 minutes – kudos to Network Solutions Customer Service folks!!

After getting the new cert and then walking through Tom S's instructions again, secure OWA via forms-based auth was back in business. What a pain.
