It looks like there may be a piece of the puzzle missing as this doesn't seem to be working. If I log onto a mailbox that is on the back-end server that is in the same admin group as the front-end server, everything seems OK. I get the normal OWA logon screen, enter username (domain not needed) and password, and I am in. If I log onto a mailbox on the back-end server in a different admin group, I get the normal OWA logon screen, enter username and password, I get the message, "You could not be logged on to Outlook Web Access. Make sure your domain\user name and password are correct, and then try again".

I used this article <http://support.microsoft.com/kb/555053> when I originally set up the environment several months ago. I just installed this other Exchange server in a new admin group the other day. I haven't made any other changes.
