We are running Exchange 2007 on Windows 2003. Our Domain controllers are Windows 2003.
Is it possible to set an Exchange server to point to a specific Domain Controller for all authentications and other tasks it needs a DC for. Normally it would pick one in random within the site.

The DC the server uses for authentication and what Exchange uses for configuration data are not necessarily the same things.
