> server. I have set up exchange.mydomain.com to point to the external ip of
> my firewall and have opened ports 80 and 443 to the exchange server. I am
> able to connect from the pda to OMA and OWA flawlessly. However the
> activesync keeps on asking me for my password even though I have entered in
> the correct password(I used the same password to log into OMA). When I sniff
> the connection I found that the Exchange server was sending back a 401 error.
> Any help would be greatly appreciated.

I even have an older SMT-5600 device that works against the same
ActiveSync server instance with no problems at all. I've been working
on this for hours now... ugh.
