You should always be able to log in with DOMAIN\USERNAME . You can log in with USERNAME only if the Default Authentication Domain is correctly set in IIS Manager (which it usually is by default), but there is no reason that actually supplying the domain name even when it isn't needed should break the login.

But anyway, since just using USERNAME works from the desktop, this indicates that the auth domain is correctly set. Maybe one of the authentication mechanisms is broken at the server end. Do you see anything written to any of the server's Event Logs when the login fails?
