> *WE have a server with an internal domain, lets call it abc. We now  
> want to also send and receive mail from another domain. I've done  
> this in 5.5, but I'm curious about any gotchas in Exchange 2003. The  
> clients are Outlook, mostly '97. The abc domain is our own internal  
> domain. The xyz domain is a domain we own. It probably would have  
> been better to just name the internal domain xyz, but i'm thinking it  
> would be too difficult to change a domain name on small business  
> server 2003.*  
>  
> *From research I see how to setup the server to accept mail addressed  
> to xyz. Any gotchas with that part?*

I hope you are talking about configuring recipient policies.

> *Then add e-mail addresses on the user accounts...a secondary address:  
> user@xyz.com.*

The RUS can do this for you if you configure the recipient policy correctly.

> *Will that do it?*

Yep, assuming that you also configure the external DNS MX records for the new domain.
