

Re: Q on Installing 2nd Exchange Server In Trusted Domain

>Thank you for you speedy reply. I apologize if I was not clear on the
>terminology. The domains are part of the same forest (when the second domain
>was installed it was created under the forest created with the first domain).
> Please disregard the mention of the trusts.
>One domain is in New Jersey, the other is in France. There are ~50 users at
>the locations, and the WAN link is not very high in badwidth. This is the
>reason for two Exchange servers. Users in both domains will share the same
>corporate email Domain Name space (user@123.com).
>So my questions become, in installing the Exchange server in France, what
>steps do I need to take when making this install? The same exact steps (i.e.
>ForestPrep, DomainPrep, Setup) as setting up the first Exchange server in NJ?
> When the French Exchange install runs, should it by default find the
>Exchange Organization created in NJ and be able to install as part of the
>same Organization?
>Do you know of any resources that might detail this type of setup?
>Thank you again for your help, it is greatly appreciated.
>

You don't need forestprep since you do that once per forest. See www.microsoft.com/exchange and look for the Exchange 2003 Library. That's got the deployment guide in it which will help you. When you install an additional Exchange server into the forest the system will know about the other Exchange servers because that information is inside AD so you don't have to provide the name of an existing server because AD already knows the answer.
