For example, we created a group named "D-Everyone" (since "Everyone" is not permitted) and changed the display name to "Everyone". However, we found that some users do not go through the address list, they just want to type next to the "TO" in Outlook. In this case, the server will not pickup the name since they have to type in the full name of the distribution group which in this case is "D-Everyone".

Is this the case with you also?
