- > *(via another server) running, it freezes up the users, when they are*
- > *in outlook or any kind of windows program. We tried to setup another*
- > *windows 2000 as a domain controller, so if one server restarts it*
- > *would compensate for the other, but that didn't help. Is there a way*
- > *to tell the client workstations to continue using email, and other web*
- > *services without locking up, when the main AD server has to be*
- > *restarted for maintenance?*
