>> Hi All,  
>>  
>> We have been using Exchange 5.5 (on Win NT4). We have a Canon iRC3200  
>> copier that could do LDAP queries on it to search for addresses to email  
>> scanned items to.  
>>  
>> We are migrating to Exchange 2003. When I point the Canon copier to this  
>> new Exchange server (running Win. Server 2003) and do a search for a  
>> recipient using this copier it returns no results. There are no errors ...  
>> just no results!  
>>  
>> The only information entered in the LDAP setup on the copier was the IP  
>> address of the LDAP server, the port (389), and the LDAP version (3).  
>>  
>> There are options for username, password, & domain, and LDAP "Location to  
>> Start Search". All these items are blank. I tried putting in a domain,  
>> username and password and the copier comes back with a connection error  
>> message.  
>>  
>> Can anyone give me some indication as to what I need to do?  
>>
