> Find the second mailbox she wants to send as. Open active directory users
> and computers, select view / advanced features. Get the properties of the
> associated account in active directory users and computers. On the
> exchange

> advanced tab / mailbox rights. Ensure that the account that she is
> logging

> in as has rights, both send as and receive as explicit allow.

>

> Then, have her log out of her mailbox and log back in. Add the account to
> the from field that you made the permissions change to, and attempt the
> send.

>
