If all of the servers are 2000 now you can just remove the SRS manually:

1. Stop all SRS services
2. Launch ADSIEdit
3. Go to Configuration, Services, Microsoft Exchange, Org Name, Administrative Groups, AG Name, Servername
(Where Servername is the name of the SRS server)
4. On the right, delete the "CN=Microsoft DSA" object
5. Repeat this for all remaining SRS servers

Once replication has taken place you should then be able to switch to native mode.

>> Exch2k server to delete the connector but cannot use it to
>> connect to the Exchange 2k server. After starting it, I

>> Exch Server computer could be located." ID no: c10312c8.
>> If I type in the server name, it says, Microsoft Exchange
>> Directory, ID no: DS_E_COMMUNICATIONS_PROBLEMS.

>> The Exchanger server has SP3 and runs on a Windows 2000
>> SP4 server. We don't have any Exch 5.5 computers. We are
>> running in a Windows 2000 native domain.
