I have an Exchange Server 2003, and am looking to see if there is any way I can block email that comes into the server that is addressed to a user but the sender is not on the user's address book. I want the mail to be returned to sender as undeliverable.

If not, then is there any kind of settings that I need to setup to block all spam mail and send to a particular folder. Right now, my email is being hosted with an offsite vendor and when I log on to download my emails, I have 300 a day and atleast 250 of them are junk mail. I don't want to see them in my exchange server when I move the ip address to point to my server.
