Hi Mario:

I would clean up the Setup Wizard files and try to recreate the setup disks again.

1. Search your development machine's hard drive for every instance of these files and delete them:

dkcontrl.dbf  
dkcontrl.cdx  
wzsetup.ini.

2. Delete the disk images and the compress directory.

3. Under the \\VFP directory, delete the \\distrib directory. Do not delete the Distrib.src folder!

I hope this helps.
