> The error will only happen on the other machine.*

Hi Altman,

Tables can become corrupt if the computer is disconnected from the network or loses power when the table is open. A poor network connection or unreliable power supply would explain why you are seeing this on one machine while the machine where the data is actually located is not having this problem.
