I am currently running a FoxPro for windows application under Widows 95. I have a second system, and am trying to run the SAME application under Windows 95 but getting different results.

The application runs – but when the first screen is displayed the cursor is not sitting at the first input field, therefore I must use a mouse to position the cursor in the field before I can enter the data. This program is identical on both systems – works fine in one – but not the other.

As well, the first system – that functions correctly – has 32 mb of ram (90% free)

While the second system –(running the same application) – has 64mb of ram (96% free) and I get an error indicating "insufficient memory"

Is there somewhere that I can tell the system how much memory to allot to this application?

I don't understand how the 2 systems running the SAME APPLICATION can be so different

Many thanks in advance for any help you can give me.
