I do have all of these...well, I don't have FPD 2.0 or 2.5, or FPW 2.5 (they made an FPW 2.5? It must be the only version of FoxPro I've never used), but I do have the rest. Why? Because I've developed apps in them in the past, and from time to time I need to try something in an older version of VFP to determine if I'm observing legacy behavior, or for a wide variety of reasons. I'm still supporting FPD and VFP6, 7, and 9 apps. Fortunately, I don't have any more FPW stuff hanging over my head.

In theory you could have VFP 3, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 all installed and usable at the same time. For that matter you could also have FPD 2.0, 2.5, 2.6, FPW 2.5 and 2.6 installed at the same time as well.
