Paul,

This is kind of strange. I get a page cannot be displayed error. When I look at your source, I see your confirmation page set as your products.htm page. When I copy the form into FrontPage however, I see the domain name appearing twice under the confirmation tab, which would definitely produce a page cannot be found error.

Double check this to make sure it isn't appearing twice in your properties.

You also have _derived nortbots appearing in your form code. I still think there may be an extension issue here as well.

I would recommend starting over with a new page for the form. Start from scratch, double check the form properties and do a Save As to replace the current page.
