FrontPage and others like photo impact will "trick" you into thinking you can do layout like in quark. the problem is that in quark or indesign you're working with known sizes (like a piece of paper) but on the web you never know your visitor's browser size, screen resolution, etc., so there has to be constraints such as tables or .css-p.

Once you get into laying out tables, and tables within them, cutting up images to fit in the tables etc, you'll be rolling.
