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I'd bet \$50 you're (or your host) is using a HELM control panel!

I've recently started using one on a couple of sites. This weird thing with the helm(or so I'm surmising) sometimes has added these oddball user names to my messenger/ passport log in list!

Are you able to re-type your user name and password and get in or are you unable to get into the site.

I would either go in through the Helm (if you're using it) and re-set the FrontPage password. then try to log-in and hope for the best.

> File >> Open Site

> and get the dialog box that comes up. I select the option for My

> Network Places. I then type in my URL for the website at the bottom

> in the Site Name text box using the following:

> <http://www.zweihigh.org>

> for the website. After that the NT User login and Password dialog box

> comes up. I type in my username and password and then click OK so

> that it will send the information to the server so I can log in.

> After about a minute or so the NT User login and Password dialog box

> comes back up again, except that this time the damn thing now has the
