Inserting a script on a DWT, is the same as inserting the script on each individual page, just that you only have single location to make any changes to it.

As each page is loaded in a browser, the script starts over with it's initial menu state, it doesn't pass the menu state between pages.

Can you provide URLs of site where you have seen this? Also you could do a view source to see what script those sites are using.

> dynamic drive. I then used Dynamic Web template to make it appear on my
> other pages. When I click on a selection from the switch menu, it collapses
> as it should providing me with options in the sub menu to click. When I
> click on the sub menu link, it goes to the page that it was hyperlinked to.
> Here is my problem, the menu on the linked page does not remain collapsed as
> it should. Instead, it contracts to its original position. I have to click
> on it again to open the menu and make another selection. This is frustrating.
> I have seen web sites where this is implemented. How can I fix this so that
> the menu remains open until another menu selection is made? I thought DWT
> was supposed to help with this type of stuff. I will greatly appreciate any
> help.
