C:\Inetpub\wwwroot\Romet and <http://localhost/romet> both point to the same exact location on your HD, the only different is the C:\Inetpub\wwwroot\Romet is opening the site as disk-based and <http://localhost/romet> as server-based. Since you have a server, then is better to open and work on the site as server-based.

You can always publish to a disk-based location as backup from the server location by, for example, publishing to c:\romet.
