|| okay. Somehow, somewhere in the system it is taking the
|| fishershomeforsale.com domain name and always trying to us it to publish to.
|| Possibly I have corrupted some other files or something, because I had
|| everything working great a week ago. Any ideas?? thanks very much for your
|| help, I really appreciate it.
