Hello,

1. On problematic client, open IE and then click Internet Options on Tools menu.
2. Click connection tab and then click LAN Settings.
3. Make sure you have not selected Automatically detect settings and Use automatic configuration script.
4. Clear the Exceptions and then click OK.
5. Click Advanced tab on Internet Options.
6. Make sure you have selected Enable Integrated Windows Authentication.
7. Try to see if the problem still occurs.
