another thing I saw in the newsgroup is the authentication, i have changed the firewall policy to have Authenitcated users only instead of all users.

I shall say that some have detected it but there are still some clients who did not.

On those computers, if you go to this precise URL, do you get prompted to download wpad.dat? <http://wpad/wpad.dat>

If not and they are on DHCP, you are not passing the default DNS domain via DHCP.

If not and they are on static IP's, you need to change the computer name so it is fully qualified with the DNS domain. Click the More... button on the dialog box with the computer name ("primary DNS suffix").
