

Re: ISA 2004 HTTP Filter

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NTFS security will not help in this case, because the site is used both by the internal domain and the isa domain, permission are being handled by a third party application, based on windows authentication, I dont want the external users to be able to even try to authenticate with internal users accounts user\password.(Top level paranoid)

I have captured http packets with network monitor and found the packed that i need to filter out.

The problem is that I need to filter only the part with the domain name (I cannot create a separate filter fo every internal username.....)

Im looking for a way to use something like %string% or *string* .

users have to authenticate again with basic authentication to the internal site.

I want to allow authentication only with a user from a specific domain, and to "filter out" all attempts to use basic authentication with other domains.

The easiest way to achieve this if you're using IIS would be to leave ISA alone and configure NTFS security on your website to allow access only with the user account(s) you want. Is this not an option?
