Hi, while trying to validate username and password on login form I am presented with the following error message

Microsoft JET Database Engine error '80040e10'

No value given for one or more required parameters.

The 2 fields within the database are text fields (UID) and (PWD) these are spelt correctly!

sqlStr = "Select * From tblusers where username = " & _  
& Request.Form("UID") & " and password = " & Request.Form("PWD") & ""
```

No – they're not spelt correctly. In your SQL statement you refer to two fields called username and password, yet you said they are called UID and PWD. Which is correct?
