I allready tried different types of date (YY/MM/DD and others).  
The "date" Filed is formatted as Time/Date Field in Access.

```
SELECT * FROM <tabelle> WHERE date > '31.12.2006' ORDER BY Datum DESC
```

Date literals have to be delimited with octathorps (#). In Jet, they should use the YYYY-MM-DD format.

Of course, if you use parameters, then you don't have to worry about sql injection or delimiters:
