> *I want to start by saying how much I have enjoyed seeing all the help
people get here! Up until now I have only read posts, but recently I am have
been runing into trouble. I am new to IIS and I have recently deployed a
Windows 2000 Exchange 5.5 OWA Server.*

> *This is a fresh install of Windows 2000, IIS5, and OWA 5.5 with SP4. I am
seeing many IIS and ASP errors in the event log, and the inetinfo task is
regularly using 99% system resources. Restarting fixes the issues, but they
always come back a few hours later. Here are the errors I am getting:*
