Ever since I installed Office 2003 last evening, I have not been able to use IE to go to any <http://localhost/...> addresses.

I am running Windows XP (Pro, of course). What I get when I try these addresses now is either a hang (status bar perpetually "trying"), or a partial HTML display (as in, perhaps the last 300 bytes of the index.htm, for example).

I've already tried rebooting, stopping and restarting IIS, adding and removing virtual IIS folders. IE will display these pages just fine, including references to stylesheets and so on, if I attempt to open from Windows Explorer (this action, as far as I understand, doesn't involve IIS, as it's a "local" open, just as if it were a Word document or such).

Any ideas?
