> Hello, I'm having a problem in the company, I'm developing ASP and ASP .Net Pages in my machine (XP) and SQL Server 2000, but the intranet server and the Sql Server 2000 are running in a Windows 2003 server, when I try to connect from my computer (XP) I receive an error:
> Microsoft OLE DB Provider for SQL Server (0x80004005)
> Login failed for user 'xxx'. Reason: Not associated with a trusted SQL Server connection.
> But when I try to run THE SAME PAGE from the windows 2003 server (Intranet Server) I have no problems, it runs beautiful, so, the problem is, my pages runs only in a 2003 server environment and the problem is that I need the pages to run in XP and 2000 workstations, I'm kinda stuck with this, can anyone help me please, thanks in advance.
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
