> Hi,

>

> I'm using ISAPI dll which runs on IIS6 web server(OS: Windows 2003) and
> tries to connect to SQL Server 2000 installed in Windows 2003 Server. I
> have installed Service Pack 2 for SQL Server in the Windows 2003 server.

>

> The web server and database server are on different PC'. But when I tries
> to connect to the SQL Server through the ISAPI web site I get the
> following error in the browser:

>

> "[DBNETLIB][ConnectionOpen (Connect()).]SQL Server does not exist or
> access denied."

>

> Everything works fine if the OS is Windows 2000 Server, SQL Server 2000 and
> IIS 5.

>

> If the ISAPI Web site (IIS 6) and the SQL Server 2000 are on the same
> Windows 2003 Server, then also everything is fine, the error is raised
> only when the Web Server (IIS 6) and the database server are on different
> PC'.

>

> Does anyone has any solutions for this? How do i solve this? Do I
> need to make/change any settings in SQL Server 2000/Windows 2003 Server or
> IIS6 to make it work with?
