What you observe is not a problem and by-design.

ASP does not use the kernel response cache, and its scripts cannot be cached in the IIS file cache. ASP handles it on its own -- this is why you see ASP-specific counters.

Hi,

I have enabled caching of ASP contents on my web server - windows 2003 standard edition IIS 6 worker process isolation.

The performance counters,

ASP - script engine cache

ASP - script engine cache hit %

ASP - template cache

these above 3 counters show values, the cache hit % is always above 99% which is good.

But there's a problem, Web Service Cache - File Cache Misses counter keeps on increasing with the number of requests web server gets.

In Web Service Cache and Kernel Cache, they all counters show up as 0.

Any idea about what can be reason of files not being cached?
