Thanks for the reply,

SP2 does indeed impact the security. It is either taking away the privilege for IUSR and IWAM to "Create Token Objects" and/or adding a new privilege called "Create Token Objects" (which I doubt, and could easily determine, but don't have the time to), of which it is not adding IUSR and IWAM to. I confirmed this by simply adding IUSR and IWAM to have that privilege and then IIS and CGI worked.
