> I set the security settings in IIS to serve ASP, and almost everything
> else. When using our app, the user enters his login and password on the
> first screen and clicks "Login", but the app doesn't do anything. No
> postback, no error, nothing.
> When I run the app locally on the 2003 box, the user clicks "Login"
and
> all of the validators on the page show up (they shouldn't), and it still
does
> nothing.
> When I try to run the app using Firefox instead of IE, it works fine!
