> We have IS running on our desktop machines and we all  
> index and have full rights to 40,000 files across our  
> network on our server. The number in the 'Total Docs'  
> field under IS in the MMC on all our workstations always  
> says 40,000 which is what we expect; however a machine tht  
> was displaying 40,000 the other day is now displaying just  
> 2000 in the Total Doc field. The server files have not  
> been changed and the other workstations still say 40,000  
> which is correct.

> The machine that display 2000 does not return the same  
> files in a search as the other workstations and so the  
> 2000 number is not just a display error, but infact real  
> as far as that machine is concerned.

>

> NOTE - this problem happen once before on a different  
> machine, but over the next day it resolved itself back to  
> 40,000.

> Any ideas why this is happening and what can be done to  
> stop it?
