I am running Firefox 2.0 on Windows XP Modem edition with SP 2 using a Linksys wireless router on a cable modem and have no problems accessing any site. I just upgraded to IE 7.0 but cannot get access to any site. I get an error message that there is a connection problem. When I run the connection diagnostics I get the following:

It appears that there is something in IE 7.0 that will not allow a connection to the internet. I tried going back to IE 6 but I cannot do that because a newer version (IE 7.0) is detected. Any ideas on how to resolve the connection problem.
